This gradebook helps see your strengths and weaknesses, as well as inconsistencies. See examples below:

Green arrow shows that Big Picture is consistently strong on every assessment.

Yellow arrow shows that Society and Culture has been very inconsistent

Red arrow shows that Interaction and Conflict has been a struggle all semester

Black arrow shows that Sample has done really well in Geography before. This score doesn't make sense. Maybe he should consider a retake?

Total with Diag: This total includes relevant practice AND tests/projects. If there is a major difference between this and "Standard Average" it tells me I should have a conversation with the student

Standard Mode: This row helps show consistent patterns in how a student is doing, and makes it easier to identify a fluke

Standard Average: This row shows the true grade for each standard, counting only tests and projects (Type S)

For example, this is an average of everything that counts for just the Geography standard.

Here is another pattern. Sample didn't turn in his homework for Ideas and Innovations (shown by "Z"). His test score is understandably low

Grade: This is an average of each standard (weighted according to importance) that has shown demonstrations of knowledge. This is the current grade in the class. Using our conversion chart, Sample has a B- right now so your Parent Portal will show Current Grade of 82%..
