# Required Supplies To be used ONLY for Psychology

- 1 spiral notebook
- 1" binder OR a very tough folder (Most of our assignments and resources will be on Google Classroom, but any that are not must be kept together.
- Numerous Pencils or Pens (enough to get through the school year)

## Additional supplies that may be helpful

- Sticky divider tabs or small sticky notes to separate units in the spiral notebook
- Colored pencils (I do provide these, but bringing your own reduces germ spreading and ensures you have the colors you want)
